

Connect Groups – FAQ's

What is the purpose of Connect groups?

Making disciples by connecting with one another through small groups and by connecting with the community through ministry.

Do Connect groups have to meet on Sundays at 5:00 PM?

Absolutely not. We encourage Connect groups to meet at any point during the week that allows for our groups to get together. We just try to interfere with our other church-wide programming. Sunday's at 5:00 is an available time slot for those groups that need it.

Do Connect groups have to meet on the church campus?

Absolutely not. It is strongly encouraged for the Connect groups to meet in places off of the campus. Homes, restaurants, coffee shops, etc all serve as great locations for Connect groups to meet. The Fellowship campus is available for use by those groups that need it.

Do Connect groups all have to use the same provided list of small groups questions?

It is strongly encouraged so that all groups will be working through the same stuff, but it is not absolutely required. What is expected is a systematic approach to discipleship to take place in all of our Connect groups.

What does it take to form a new Connect group?

A leader and a good idea. It's almost that simple. We encourage the forming of new groups. Find a good place to meet. Find a good time to meet. Determine a ministry project for your group.

Does every Connect group have to have a ministry project?

They need to be involved in one. Whether it is their own unique project or they partner with another group, each Connect group needs to be involved in a ministry project.
