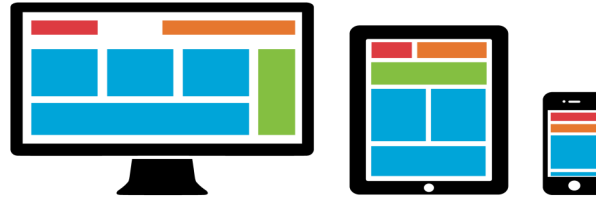

Who was Lottie Moon?

She was born Charlotte Digges Moon, December 12, 1840, in Virginia. Lottie rebelled against Christianity until she was in college. In December, 1858, she dedicated her life to Christ and was baptized at First Baptist Church, Charlottesville, Virginia. At 32 years old, she had turned down a marriage proposal, left her home and followed God's lead to China. The people feared and rejected her but she drew them to her house with her fresh baked cookies. She learned their language, customs, and wore traditional Chinese clothes. She wrote many letters home regarding the Chinese people's hunger for truth and the need for more missionaries. She helped lay the foundation for what is now the modern Chinese church. She died at the age of 72. The WMU annual Christmas offering was named for her in 1918.

Pastor's Reflections

Bro. Corey Fontan

O Lord, make me know my end and what is the measure of my days; let me know how fleeting I am!

~ Psalm 39:4

One of the things that we don't do well as human beings is that we don't think appropriately about matters of life, death, and eternity. If we did, it would spoil all the fun, thus the devil and the culture work very hard to prevent us from thinking on these things. They do so by keeping us amused and entertained by the things of this world. The word *amusement* is a compound word made up of two parts. The heart of the word is *muse* which means to "meditate" or "think". The prefix *a* is a negative, which means "no" or "not". So, amusement means to "not think". This is what most of us do as we drift through life and approach the doors of death and into eternity. However, we all must come to the realization that we are going to die. It's okay to say it. It's okay to talk about it. It's good to prepare for it. The Psalmist here prays that God will constantly remind him that he will not be here forever. This Psalm is a prayer that we not live our lives constantly amused by the worldly culture but that we spend adequate time thinking about these matters of great importance. Are you prepared for death to visit you?

- Have you made your preparations to stand before God? He is your Judge and one day you will give an account to Him.
- Have you made preparations for your funeral so that your family doesn't have to? I have a "Funeral Preparation Checklist" that I'd be happy to pass on to you that will be helpful to you and your loved ones.
- Have you planned who will get your stuff? Consider leaving some to your church so that you can continue building the kingdom of God even after you are gone.

Think about death and embrace its reality. And thank God that death is not the end.

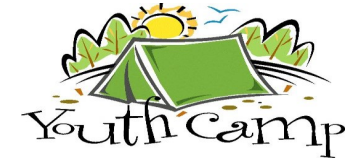
Youth group is made up of students grade 7-12.

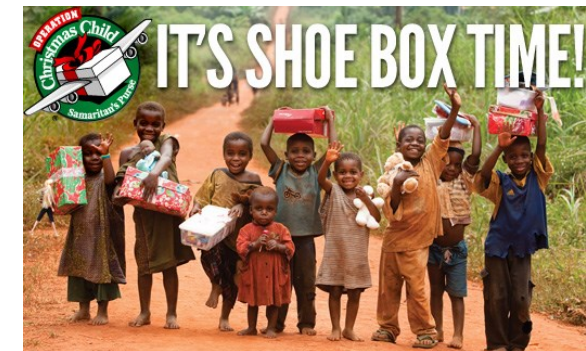
